Comment from Consultative Group Member Peter L. Strauss on *Disclosure of Agency Legal Materials*July 21, 2022

Repeating the comments made at that first session, I suggest rewording (2) to read "Access to rules, including guidance documents and industrial standards incorporated by reference."

FOIA is not mentioned as such, though 552(a)(1, 2) and (b)(5 and 7), are implicit in 2 and 3, respectively. Earlier it had seemed as if that statutory access package generally (FOIA, E-FOIA, E-Gov., etc) would be an organizing focus. Does it belong in the list?
