My name is Steven Caruso, and I am named on 45 issued patents.

In short, I don't believe that the creation of a small claims court will do anything. Unless a patent owner is just playing "whack a mole" with large numbers of extremely small infringers, which is overly resource-intensive for any kind of reasonable ROI, and thus a problematic path; the dollar amounts normally being considered in infringement cases far exceed the ceiling of small claims courts.

Furthermore, one of the root problems is not being addressed which is proper injunctive relief regardless of court type/classification.

Finally, the focus of this should not be a "small claims " court, but rather a "small entities" court. That is what is needed.
